Purpose for which personal data is to be processed and the legal grounds:

LBBW processes your personal data for providing the newsletter on current topics, the industry and events. The legal grounds are Article 6 (1a) GDPR (consent).

Categories of personal data to be processed and their sources:

LBBW processes your name and your contact data, such as your e-mail address for sending out the newsletter. Your data are collected directly from you.

Recipient or categories of recipients of the personal data:

LBBW transfers your personal data only to entities LBBW must transfer your data to due to statutory regulations.

Processors LBBW uses for orders can also receive data for these purposes. These are companies in the categories of IT services, logistics, printing services and telecommunications.

Data controller's intention to transfer the personal data to a third country or an international organization:

No such intention exists.

Duration for which the personal data will be stored, or, if this is not possible, the criteria for determining the duration:

LBBW saves your personal data for the period in which consent exists. After revocation of your consent or discontinuation of the reason, your personal data are no longer saved.

Information on whether the provision of personal data is legally or contractually required or necessary to conclude a contract, and whether the data subject is obliged to provide the personal data and the possible consequences of a failure to provide such data:

You are neither legally nor contractually required to provide your personal data to LBBW. Not providing your data means that in future you cannot be informed by newsletter.

Data subject rights:

Every data subject has the right to receive information under Art. 15 GDPR, the right to rectification under Art. 16 GDPR, the right to erasure under Art. 17 GDPR, the right to restriction of processing under Art. 18 GDPR, and the right to data portability under Art. 20 GDPR. In the case of the right to access of data and the right to erasure, the limitations set out in Sections 34 and 35 of GDPR apply. In addition, there is a right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, Article 77 GDPR in conjunction with section 19 FDPA.
